The annual DeRose-Hinkhouse Memorial Awards are given to active members of RCC who demonstrate excellence in religious communication and public relations.

The awards are named in honor of the late *Victor DeRose* and the late *Paul M. Hinkhouse*, leading lithographers in New York City, and longtime friends of the RCC. Both men shared a strong interest in, and concern for, excellence in communications.

This year RCC received 212 entries. Each entry was judged on overall quality, including concept, writing, design, creativity, style, use of color, appropriateness of material for intended audience, creative use of resources, and effectiveness in achieving its purpose. Faculty members from the Journalism and Mass Communications Department at Marshall University in Huntington, W.Va., were responsible for judging the projects of religion communication professionals across the country. *The Marshall University School of Journalism and Mass Communications (SOJMC)* department offers a Bachelor of Arts degree with seven majors and a graduate program accredited by the *Association for Education in Journalism and Mass Communications*. SOJMC alumni can be linked to U.S. News & *World Report, CNN, PBS* and a *Pulitzer Prize*winning newspaper editor.

Marshall University is the fourth university to judge DeRose-Hinkhouse entries over the past six years. *Eastern Illinois University, Belmont University* and *University of Chattanooga at Tennessee* evaluated entries in the past.




SHOESTRING AWARD
